**Minutes of the extraordinary meeting of Thornton Curtis Parish Council held at 8.00 pm on
Thursday 18th April 2013 in Goxhill Parish Rooms, Howe Lane, Goxhill**

1. Apologies for Absence Cllr C Couch, Ferry Ward Cllrs P Clark and D Wells.
2. To Note Declaration of Interest Forms were submitted to the Clerk from Cllr R Brixton, Cllr I Whelpton, Cllr P Grainger, Cllr E Davey, Cllr S Leach and Cllr A Tulloch for dispensation to participate in the meeting. Dispensation was granted under para (c) in that it was in the interests of persons living in the Council's area and para (e) in that it was otherwise appropriate.
3. To Suspend the Meeting and Receive Public Participation Members of the public did not wish to comment.
4. To Resolve the exclusion of the public from the meeting. Cllr Davey proposed that there was no reason to exclude the public from the meeting, and this was resolved.
5. To Resolve the Council's position regarding Planning Application WD/2013/0339 After a detailed discussion of concerns regarding flooding, increased HGV traffic and environmental issues, Cllr Davey proposed that the Council should object to the planning application, this was seconded by Cllr Tulloch and unanimously resolved. Cllr Brixton agreed to compose a letter on behalf of the Council based on the research submitted to the meeting. Mr Davey proposed that the Council should write an additional letter to Rod Chapman of the Highways Dept outlining the concerns over flooding. Seconded by Cllr Whelpton and resolved. The Clerk was also requested to contact the Environment Agency regarding the Flood Risk Mapping."
