**Minutes of the Previous Meeting**

The minutes of the meeting held 8<sup>th</sup> May 2006 were agreed correct and signed as such.

**Matters Arising**

Play Area – Nothing resolved, some of the trustees are not in favour of selling. It is hoped to have some options for the next meeting. The possibility of a cemetery was mentioned as the churchyard is full, but access might be a problem.

Footpath – Work had been started and the footpath cleared, Cllrs Brixton & Crampin are liaising with North Lincs representatives. The next stage is to have the hedges cut back, some of which are farmer's hedges but the majority are private. The pedestrian warning signs have been erected but not in the correct place. The main road to Wootton also needs the hedges cutting back also the trees need trimming in Laurel Lane but as it is a private road who is responsible is not known.

Seat – Various options have been considered, it was agreed that simplicity is the best option, an inexpensive plain seat, less chance of it being stolen.

Church clock – Cllr Tulloch had been given information but the cost would be very high and doesn't actually need a clock repairer but a builder, although it is impossible to get a cherry picker into the churchyard. Cllr Tulloch will investigate further.

Village Pump – Thanks were expressed to Cllr Mrs Hargreaves and to Susie for planting and tending the pump, it is a credit to them.

**Highways and Transport**

Cllr Mrs Hargreaves brought up the 40mph limit on Station Road, the clerk will find out the criteria for a speed limit.

Complaints have been received regarding cars parking on the footpath on both Main Street and Station Road, the clerk will inform Pc White.

Drains on Main Street sunk and flooding on Station Road, these will be reported.
