**Matters arising**

**Play Area** – Mr J. Farrow had requested sight of the minutes of about 1985, unfortunately they have yet to be located, the clerk will endeavour to find where they are. Cllr Crampin had obtained a copy of some deeds which show that the boundaries belong to the properties. One intention was to sell the area as it cost money to upkeep, however the trustees have to agree, and at present we have no agreement. The item, it was agreed will be held over to the next meeting.

**Footpath**- Cllr Brixton informed the members of the progress. North Lincs Council had sent letters asking those with hedges on Station Road to trim them back. All but two have complied; Mr Dixon will approach the remaining two and ask them to cut their hedges. A 40mph had been suggested by a councillor but Station Road does not fulfil the criteria.

**Village matters**

Access and parking for the station is again causing concern. The various agencies will be contacted. There has been a problem with the drains, however highways are trying to resolve the matter.

**Highways & transport**

The bus was discussed; Cllr Wardle is fighting on behalf of the village.

Cllr Brixton will be attending the railway group meeting; he felt it would be worthwhile if the station could be spruced up a bit.

**Planning**

2006/1309 English Heritage – to make provision for more parking at Thornton Abbey- the parish council were in agreement with this application but commented that there should be toilet facilities.
