1. Apologies Apologies were received and accepted from Ferry Ward Cllrs D. Wells & J. Wardle
2. Declaration of Interests This item was explained by the clerk
3. Minutes of the previous meeting The minutes of the meeting held 7th July were agreed a correct record and signed as such.
4. Co-option of Councillor (Mr Grainger left the room at this point) There had been 1 applicant for the vacant position, Mr P. Grainger. It was proposed by Cllr Mrs Hargreaves, seconded Cllr Whelpton and agreed by all present that Mr P. Grainger be co-opted.
5. Matters Arising
 - i. Standing orders -There was one minor adjustment to make at No 7 (and changed to or)
 - ii. St. Lawrence Church donation – This item to be deferred until the November meeting as further clarification is needed.
 - iii. Village Fund – The clerk had been advised that an instant access saving account would receive the best interest, it was agreed that the monies be transferred.
 - iv. Station Road parking – a map had been received from North Lincs showing the access to be 2.3m wide, however after much discussion, the council members did not agree with this, the clerk will investigate further.
6. Village matters
 - i. Rural development programme- funding has been applied for, the Church has made a submission.
 - ii. Hedge trimming, the majority has been done.
 - iii. Play area – the clerk will apply for a dog control order.
7. Highways & Transport
 - i. Station Road footpath – NLC are waiting for funding but it will be 'repaired.' The main concern is that the same material will be used, Cllr Clark will try for some answers.
 - ii. Work on the flood prevention gullies is still outstanding, the chair will write to the authorities.
 - iii. Footpath Thornton to Wootton- The chair has had numerous discussions with S. Harrison but the outcome is that nothing will be changed.
 - iv. Cllr Brixton -Railway – there have been lots of cancellations in the last 3 months, there is a shortage of staff on the transpennine line so staff have been taken off the Barton-Cleethorpes route. BCCRP are trying hard to promote the line.
 - v. Cllr Whelpton- Humberside Airport – The airport are applying to the civil aviation authority for the re classification of airspace, the council agrees with the application, Cllr Whelpton will deal with the matter.
