Minutes of the meeting held Monday 1st November 2010

1. Apologies – Apologies were received from the Ward Cllr J. Wardle
2. Declarations of Interest – Cllr Mrs Hargreaves declared a personal & prejudicial interest in planning 2010/1185 and would leave the room while this item was discussed. Cllr Grainger declared a personal interest in the play area.
3. Public Participation –i. Play area – the committee had met and two members had been cutting the grass, the committee requested if the parish council would be prepared to pay for a monthly grass cut, the parish council agreed to pay for six cuts per annum. The hedge; it had been decided to trim the lower hedge round the sides, quote will be obtained. There was a lot of concern re speeding traffic through the village. ii. The planning application for Northfield Farm was discussed at great length. Mr Tremberg read out his objections as an adjacent property and other members of the public stated their objections. In short they are:- Not conforming to LDF, No significant social or housing need, Inconsistent with character of village, Many agricultural buildings in village, would set a precedent, Traffic flow, safety risk to public, no footpath would have to cross busy A1077, Proposed enlargement of existing barn not viable, long windows & skylights intrude over neighbouring properties, Reasons why the development plans are being applied for in separate applications. Issue that the developer is extending the area. Also concerns that the pits might be filled in and the full implications if this happened as the pits helped prevent flooding in the village. The Chair assured everyone present that the parish council will put their objections forward, also if any request was received for the infill of the pits a parish council/ village meeting would be held.
4. Minutes of the previous meeting – The minutes of the meeting held 6th September 2010 were approved and signed as a correct record.
5. Matters arising – i. Letter from Rob Beales re A1077 footpath concludes not previously a footpath, contradicting the issue at the January petition meeting – A response letter will be sent. ii. Notice board repaired – no account received as yet. iii. Traffic calming measures –to be discussed at next meeting (NLC will look at 30mph limits next year)
