



Parish Emergency Plan

The Thornton Curtis Parish Council has been charged by North Lincolnshire Council with drawing up a plan to respond to a major incident. Such an incident would be judged to be beyond the capacity of normal emergency services (Police, Fire Brigade, Ambulance) and so is most unlikely to happen. However possible risks that have been identified are:

Prolonged isolation through floods

Prolonged loss of electrical power

A major spillage of hazardous materials in the village or nearby

A major flu or some such epidemic disabling, for a period, normal services

In the unlikely event of such an emergency the Parish Council has established a Community Emergency Team. They are:

The team will meet at the Thornton Hunt Inn to co-ordinate the village response and this is where, if an emergency is declared, requests for help and offers of assistance will be coordinated. It is a feature of the plan that we maintain a record of those who might be considered vulnerable for whatever reason (e.g. through prolonged loss of electric power, in need of regular medical aid). We would also request that, if you have been cleared by the Criminal Record Bureau to work with children or vulnerable adults, that you make this known to the Council, so that we may draw on your assistance if needed. If you feel you have equipment, or particular skills that may be of use, we would like to hear from you also.
