Minutes of the meeting of Thornton Curtis Parish Council held at 8.00 pm on Monday 9<sup>th</sup> March 2015 in St Lawrence's Church, Main Street, Thornton Curtis.

- 1. To Note Apologies for Absence. Cllr P Grainger, Ferry Ward Cllrs P Clark and D Wells.
- 2. To Note Declarations of Interest. Cllr Leach declared a pecuniary interest in item 5, i.
- 3. <u>To Receive Public Participation</u>. There were no members of the public present.
- **To Resolve the Minutes of the Previous Meeting**. The minutes of the meeting held on Monday 5<sup>th</sup> January 2015 were proposed by Cllr Couch as a true and correct record. Seconded by Cllr Leach and resolved.

## 5. <u>To Resolve Matters Arising.</u>

- i. Hilly Pits. The refusal of WD 2014/0339 by the planning committee was noted, and discussions took place regarding the appeal process. It was resolved that the clerk should contact the Environmental Health and Environments Team at NL Council to enquire whether the recent dumping of horse manure at the site constituted a statutory nuisance and contravened the Habitats Regulations for great crested newts.
- ii BCCRP. Cllr Brixton gave an update from the meeting on 3<sup>rd</sup> March. The franchise is due to change in 2017, and sections will be closed after Christmas 2015 for 17 days for modifications between Habrough and Grimsby.
- iii College Road polytunnels. It was agreed to put this item on hold due to the recent vandalism of the polytunnels which has killed all the fish.
- iv College Road solar panels. As above.
- v The Grange. Clerk was requested to chase up the Highways Dept regarding the front highways boundary.
- vi Station Road hedge trimming/weed control. Clerk to ask Cllr Wells to chase this up. Clerk to request the occupants of Spruce Lodge to cut back the hedge width from the path surface.
- vii A1077 footpath weed control. Clerk to ask Cllr Wells to chase this up.
- viii Thornton Abbey picnic site. The bridge is still in the workshop.
- ix Refurbishment of benches Cllr Couch agreed to pursue this now the weather has improved.
- x Public Defibrillator/training day. Clerk was requested to obtain a date for the training day, and Cllr Couch agreed to put this in the newsletter. Clerk to enquire when the defibrillator unit will be installed.

- xi Noticeboard. The order has been placed and should arrive this month.
- xii Broadband/Virgin Media. Fibre Optic broadband should be available by the end of March, but may not reach the bulk of the village. Cllr Brixton agreed to pursue this item.
- xiii Replacement 30 mph sign Burnham Lane and clearance of 30 mph sign A1077 has been completed. Clerk to follow up the request for a new Main Street nameplate.
- ix Hedge at Champions Gate. The hedge still needs trimming on the roadside. Clerk to follow up.
