



## **COMMUNITY EMERGENCY PLAN**

### **Potential Risks**

- Floods or snow isolating the village.
- Major accident: traffic, rail or aircraft.
- Fire.
- Pandemic.
- Loss of electricity.
- Wind damage.
- Collapse of buildings.
- Serious criminal or terrorist activity.

In the event of a major emergency being announced by Government, North Lincs Council or Parish Council, members of the emergency committee who are available should meet at the Thornton Hunt Inn. The Hunt will act as headquarters.

The committee members should:

- appoint an 'emergency chair'.
- liaise with the Council through the emergency number (held by the Chair and the Hunt).
- identify who may be at risk, and any further risks.
- locate, as necessary, accommodation, suitable equipment, available supplies and medical equipment, qualified and skilled personnel (including DBS cleared).
- prepare a plan embracing severity, potential duration, level of risk to individuals, sources of internal and external help.
- publicise this plan throughout the village, including outlier communities
- continue to liaise with NLC as necessary.
