1. Report on the year by Parish Council Chair  
*Cllr Hargreaves said it had been a quieter year than previously and there were positive things to report. The village had gained a Bronze award on its first entry into East Midlands in Bloom, bulb planting on the church wall was very successful and the creation of a children's garden on the playing field completed the field. He thanked everyone involved in the VEDay80 celebrations, including the Thornton Hunt. A meeting with the Head of Highways had produced a quick response to some of the necessary works but not to the worst area – the crossroads to Burnham. HGV's are a problem at the moment with College Road being closed and lorries also coming through the village to access the Yarborough Estate at Brocklesby.*
